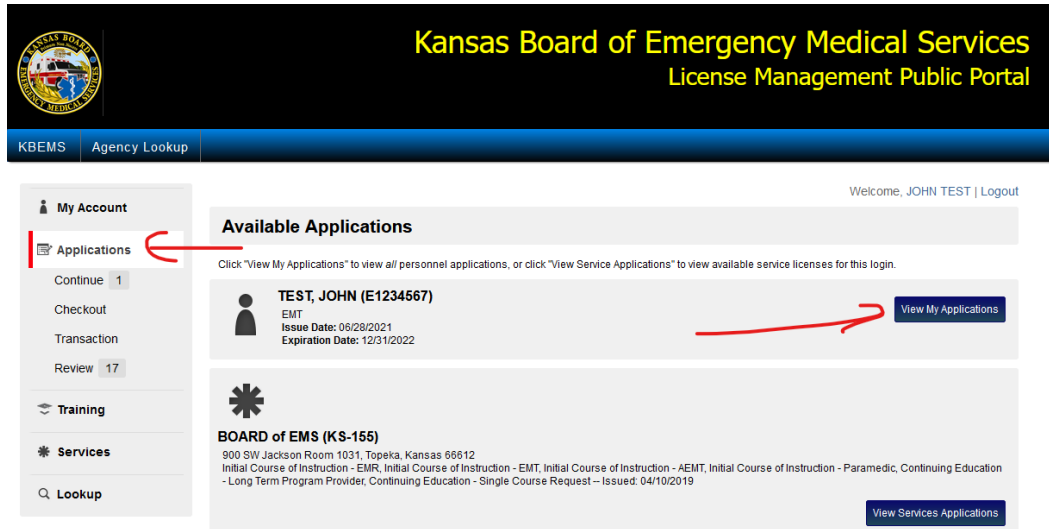


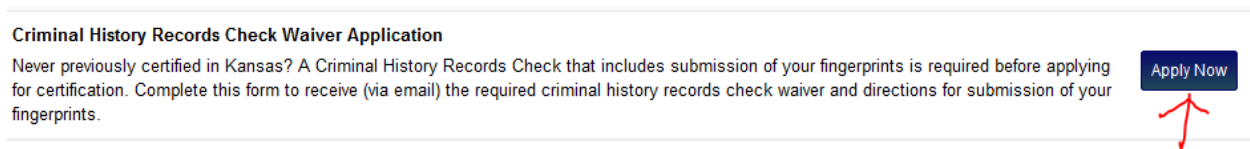
Criminal History Records Check Waiver Application.

New applicants for EMS credentials in the State of Kansas will be required to undergo criminal history records checks prior to gaining certification. This will entail the completion of a waiver and submission of fingerprints taken at an authorized location. Complete this form to receive (via email) the required criminal history records check waiver and directions for submission of your fingerprints.

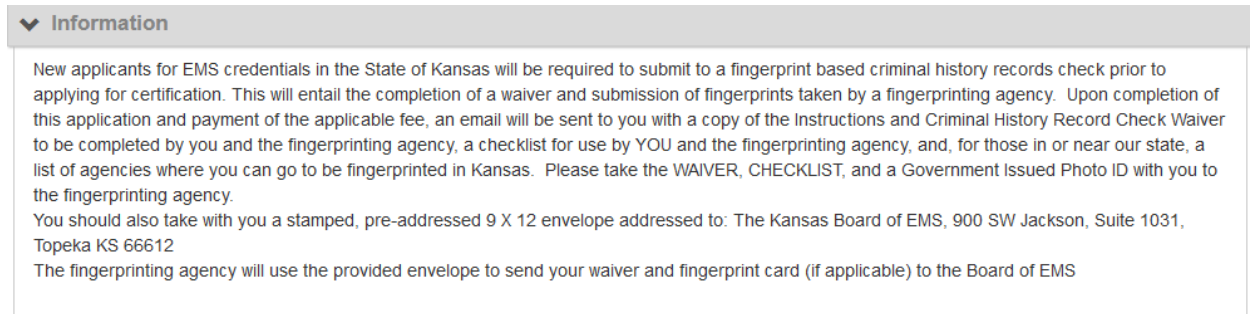
First locate the “Criminal History Check Waiver Application” by clicking on “Applications”, then “View My Applications”.
